Whether he writes for his band, the concert stage or film/tv, his music is both aggressive and introspective. 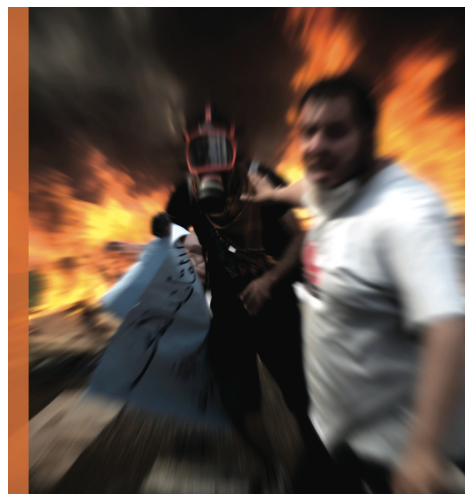
